



#### in a nutshell




#### Revenues vs. Expenses

#### From March Presentation

- History
  - Steady deficit progression over the past 5 years
  - Reserve Study shows we should have \$2.1M
    - Special Assessment to bring us up?
- What is our Reserves now?
  - Total Reserve Cash = \$211,363
  - Amount due from Operating to Reserve = (\$634,738)
- Action's Suggestion
  - 20% mid-year increase

### RESERVES - cont'd

- How much do we put into the Reserves every month?
- How much have we funded to date?
- What did the Reserve Study recommend?

	Monthly Contributions		Funded to Date		Percent Funded
2013 - Reserve Account	\$	11,421	\$	45,684	5.29%
Reserve Study Recommendation	\$	118,033	\$	1,416,396	54.70%
